# **OPTAVIA IMPACT SUMMIT 2024 REGISTRATION:**

### **OFFICIAL TERMS & CONDITIONS**

THE **OPTA**VIA IMPACT SUMMIT 2024 (THE "SUMMIT") TAKES PLACE ON OCTOBER 21 - 24 2024, AT SUNDANCE MOUNTAIN RESORT AND IS SPONSORED BY **OPTA**VIA, LLC ("**OPTA**VIA", THE "COMPANY" OR THE "SPONSOR"). THE COMPANY RESERVES THE RIGHT, IN ITS SOLE DISCRETION, TO LIMIT OR DENY ACCESS TO ANY ENTITY OR INDIVIDUAL TO THE SUMMIT ("SUMMIT ATTENDEE" OR "ATTENDEE" OR "PARTICIPANT"). IF ACCESS IS DENIED BY **OPTA**VIA FOR ANY REASON, **OPTA**VIA MAY REFUND ANY UNUSED AMOUNT OF THE REGISTRATION, HOWEVER, ANY REFUND AMOUNT IS AT THE COMPANY'S SOLE AND ABSOLUTE DISCRETION.

- 1. BINDING AGREEMENT: By participating in the Summit, the Participant (the "independent OPTAVIA Coach" or the "Coach") fully and unconditionally agrees to accept these Official Terms & Conditions ("Terms & Conditions") and the decisions of the Sponsor, which are final and binding in all matters related to the Summit. To be eligible for the Summit, the Participant must fulfill all requirements set forth herein.
- **2. QUALIFICATION PERIOD:** The Qualification Period ("Qualification Period") for the Summit begins at 12:00 a.m. PT on June 1, 2024, and ends at 11:59 p.m. PT on August 31, 2024.
- **3. SUMMIT QUALIFICATIONS:** The Summit is open ONLY to Coaches who have met certain qualifications during the Qualification Period as follows:
  - a. Rank Criteria Perform as a Global Director (or above) each month during the Qualification Period (June, July, and August 2024).
  - b. Performance Criteria The top 95 Transformation Team accounts, with performance measured by our Top Grower report, looking at each account's Global Generation, is a combination of Client Acquisition per Coach, Sponsoring per Coach, and Volume growth over the three-month Qualification Period.

### 10. TRANSFERS POLICY:

a. Transfers of registrations for the Summit will not be permitted; no exceptions will be considered.

### 11. ADDITIONAL SUMMIT TERMS:

- a. **OPTA**VIA reserves the right to amend the Summit Terms & Conditions and the Summit details, at any time and its sole discretion.
- b. **OPTA**VIA reserves the right to interpret these Terms & Conditions at its sole discretion.
- c. **OPTA**VIA reserves the right to audit and verify that all Summit Qualifications and requirements were met compliantly and by following the **OPTA**VIA Official Policies, Procedures, Independent Coach Agreement, and the Integrated Compensation Plan or International Compensation Plan (all of these items are collectively referred to as "the Agreement"). **OPTA**VIA reserves the right to cancel any Summit registrations should it be discovered that qualifications were achieved through non-compliant activities on the part of the Coach and/or were in violation of the Agreement.
- d. To attend the Summit, in addition to meeting certain qualification requirements, an Attendee must have an active Coach account in good standing, i.e., not be under any disciplinary action, including probation, at the time the Summit takes place.
- e. To respect and preserve the professional nature of the Summit, General Sessions, and Workshops, no children will be permitted, only nursing or lap infants are allowed in these events.

By attending the Summit, the Attendee agrees to abide by all generally applicable rules and regulations governing the Summit that have been provided or otherwise made known to the Summit Attendee by **OPTA**VIA and/or any of its subsidiaries, affiliates, or parent companies, including the Independent **OPTA**VIA Coach Agreement, as well as any "virtual" meeting rules or codes of conduct. Attendees are required to observe and comply with any mandatory guidelines that are in place at the Summit venue. Failure to comply with the venue's guidelines may result in ejection from the Summit without a refund.

- i. **OPTA**VIA uses the personal data Summit Attendee provides during registration to administer your participation in this Summit. To this end, **OPTA**VIA, and/or any of its subsidiaries, affiliates, and/or parent companies, may disclose Summit Attendee's personal data to third-party service providers (e.g., any providers engaged by **OPTA**VIA to assist in conducting and administering the Summit). **OPTA**VIA, and/or any of its subsidiaries, affiliates, or parent companies, may also disclose Summit Attendee's personal data to other Summit Attendees but will do so solely in compliance with applicable data protection laws and our Privacy Policies. Except as described herein, **OPTA**VIA, and/or its subsidiaries, affiliates, and parent companies will not disclose your personal data to any other third party without your consent except where required to do so by law.
- **OPTA**VIA prohibits the recording of any Summit sessions by Summit Attendees. Summit sessions are recorded by **OPTA**VIA for training, archival, and marketing purposes. By participating in the Summit, Summit Attendee understands that all or portions of the Summit may be recorded in video and audio and/or captured in still and/or digital photographs by the Sponsor. - m. **OPTA**VIA is not responsible for and will not issue refunds to Summit Attendees for any events or issues that may delay or prohibit Summit Attendees from attending the Summit.
- n. Summit Attendees' registration for, and participation in this Summit constitutes their acknowledgment and agreement to these Terms & Conditions.
- o. Be advised that, regardless of the Event venue rules, no weapons of any kind will be permitted at the Event, including, but not limited to firearms, ammunition, and knives. Attendees who bring any weapons to the Event venue will be denied entry and forfeit their right to any refund for the Event.
- p. **OPTA**VIA is not responsible for any items that may be lost and/or stolen during or at the Event. SUMMIT CANCELLATION, SUSPENSION, OR MODIFICATION: The Sponsor reserves the right to cancel, suspend, and/or modify the Summit, without any fault or liability: (1) for any reason, (2) due to force majeure (e.g. an act of war or terror, pandemic, disaster, explosion, fire, flood, riot, the act of God, etc.), or (3) if any other factor beyond the Sponsor's reasonable control impairs the integrity or proper functioning of the Summit in any manner, or for any reason, as determined by the Sponsor in its sole discretion.
- 13. ARBITRATION: Except where prohibited by law, as a further condition of participating in this Summit, registered Summit Attendee agrees that (a) any and all disputes and causes of action arising out of or connected with this Summit, shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form of class action, and exclusively, by final and binding arbitration under the rules of JAMS (alternative dispute resolution service) ("JAMS"); (b) the Federal Arbitration Act shall govern the interpretation, enforcement, and all proceedings at such arbitration; (c) judgment upon such arbitration award may be entered in any court having jurisdiction; and (d) these Terms and Conditions shall be governed by the law of the State of Maryland. All arbitration proceedings and rulings, and all materials produced pursuant to the arbitration, shall be strictly confidential. All proceedings shall be conducted in the city of OPTAVIA's corporate headquarters. Except as prohibited by law, the parties waive all rights and claims to punitive, incidental, or consequential damages, including attorney's fees; and Summit Attendees further waive all rights to have damages multiplied or increased.
- 14. INDEMNIFICATION AND LIMITATION OF LIABILITY: BY REGISTERING FOR AND ATTENDING THE SUMMIT, EACH SUMMIT ATTENDEE AGREES TO INDEMNIFY, RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS OPTAVIA AND ITS RESPECTIVE PARENT, AFFILIATE, AND SUBSIDIARY COMPANIES, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO, MEDIFAST, INC., AS WELL AS ALL OF ITS ADVERTISING AND PROMOTIONAL AGENCIES, AND ALL THEIR RESPECTIVE OFFICERS, DIRECTORS, EMPLOYEES, REPRESENTATIVES AND AGENTS FROM ANY LIABILITY, DAMAGES, LOSSES OR INJURY (INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, DIRECT, INDIRECT, INCIDENTAL, SPECIAL, CONSEQUENTIAL OR EXEMPLARY DAMAGES) WHETHER ARISING IN TORT (INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE, WHETHER ACTIVE, PASSIVE OR IMPUTED), CONTRACT, WARRANTY, STRICT LIABILITY, RELIANCE OR UNDER ANY OTHER THEORY RESULTING IN WHOLE OR IN PART, DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY, FROM THAT SUMMIT ATTENDEE'S PARTICIPATION IN THE SUMMIT, AND WHETHER OR NOT OPTAVIA AND ITS RESPECTIVE PARENT, AFFILIATE AND SUBSIDIARY COMPANIES HAVE BEEN ADVISED OF THE POSSIBILITY OF SUCH DAMAGES.

- **16. SEVERABILITY:** If any term or other provision of these Terms & Conditions is determined to be invalid, illegal, or incapable of being enforced by any rule or law, or public policy, such provisions shall be severed and all other conditions and provisions of this Agreement shall nevertheless remain in full force and effect.
